The two-and-a-half-story massing with a cross gambrel roof that overhangs the first floor creating a full width front porch supported by Doric columns and the shingle siding are all indicative of the Shingle style. The multi-pane windows at the top of the gables, as well as the second-floor windows with the multi-pane upper sash appear to be original.

### **Significant Features**

- Cross gambrel roof over the second floor that overhangs the first floor creating a full width front porch with Doric columns.
- Shingle siding, multi-pane windows in the gable ends and at the second floor, the bay window on the first floor of the west elevation.

### **Condition**

The cottage is in good repair.
