Architectural Style Prairie style

This two-story cottage with its rectangular massing, symmetrical hip roof with deep eaves and exposed rafter tails and hip roof dormers on all four sides and symmetrical fenestration in the second floor are all indicative of the Prairie style. The wrap around front porch has square posts on top of paneled bases supporting a shallow hip roof with exposed rafter tails. The rear two-story ell with enclosed sleeping porch, as well as the rear one-story porch are common treatments.

Significant Features

- Rectangular two-story massing with symmetrical hip roof with hip roof dormers on all four sides, deep eaves with exposed rafter tails on main roof and dormers.
- Wrap around front porch with shallow hip roof with exposed rafter tails supported by square posts on top of paneled bases and central stair.
- Beveled clapboard siding and symmetrical window placement at second floor.
- Large central window flanked by smaller matching windows on south elevation, and paired windows in center of gable ends.
- Tall windows at first floor on porch and offset front door that is recessed.
- Rear one-story porch and rear ell with enclosed sleeping porch.

Condition

The cottage appears to be in good repair with no apparent issues.
