**Year Built** c. 1890

**Architectural Style** Stick style

The vertical board and batten siding, carved vergeboards and turned porch posts with carved brackets are all indicative of the Stick style. The gable front and wing (upright and wing) and two-story height are also characteristic of the style. The railing around the porch roof creating a second-floor porch has been added since 2007. The narrow two-over-two windows at the first floor on the front and south sides are typical for the Stick style era.

### **Significant Features**

- Two-story massing with gable front and possible original wing to the north (upright and wing).
- Vertical board and batten siding.
- Carved vergeboards in gable front.
- Front porch with turned posts and carved brackets.
- Tall narrow two-over-two windows at first floor on front and south side.

### **Condition**

The cottage appears to be in good repair with no apparent issues.
