Architectural Style Eclectic

This two-story gable front cottage with the clipped gable roof and cross gable, and vertical board and batten siding has the massing of the Tudor style, but decorative elements of the Stick style. The original steeply pitched roof of the wrap around porch is unusual. The addition of shed roof dormers on the west roof slope breaks up the original roof. The original front porch appears to have been closed in and gable fronts have been added.

Significant Features

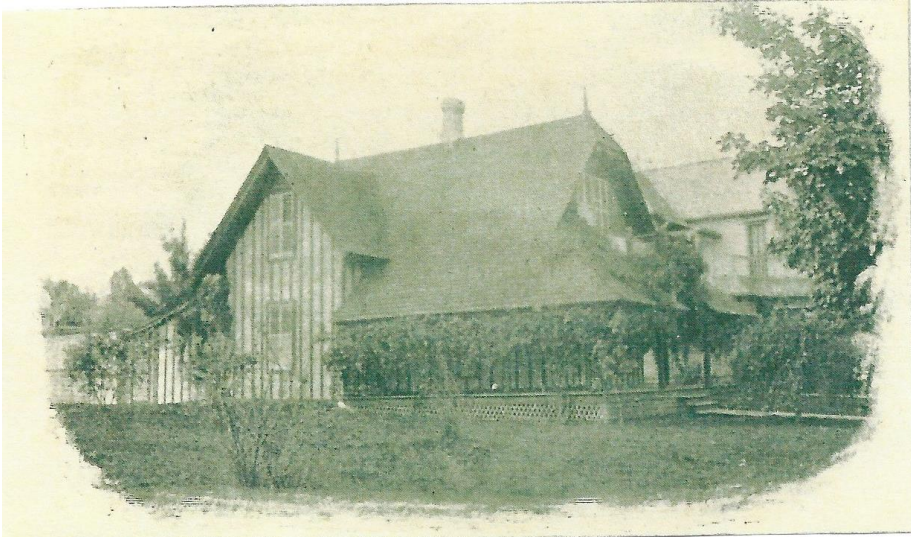
- Two story massing with steeply pitched front gable roof with cross gable, clipped gable at front and rear.
- Vertical board and batten siding.
